









Case Studies

At the middle school level, FitMoney offers 19 real-world case studies that relate to life experiences faced by teens and young adults. Our goal is that much of the learning be generated from classroom discussion. The cases can be taught in any sequence and each one is designed to be delivered in either two 20-minute sessions or a single 40-minute session, with opportunities for extension. This modular design allows for a flexible integration of FitMoney's curriculum into the middle school schedule, across a variety of advisory, support, or content areas.
